Written responses should include:

1. A letter of introduction, signed by an officer or principal of the firm with contracting authority. *Include an email address.* This address will be used by the University for all communication related to shortlist, interviews, and selection.
2. Current office size, personnel description, and workload.
3. Similar project experience with colleges and universities.
4. Projects currently under contract with state agencies or educational facilities.
5. Proof of current professional liability insurance coverage (\$1,000,000 minimum required).
6. Proof of licensure. All firms shall be licensed in the State of Arkansas by the Arkansas State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Professional Surveyors.

University welcomes proposals from firms with a diverse workforce, including women- and minority-owned firms and joint ventures including such firms.

Professional services required:

GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEERING SERVICES INCLUDING SOIL BORINGS, SOIL MECHANICS, CONCRETE TESTING, AND ENGINEERING ANALYSIS. DESIGN EARTHWORKS AND FOUNDATIONS. EVALUATE CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS.
